# *Itinerary*

## *October 18 to 27, 2020*



---

### **Day 1: Sunday, October 18 – Departure**

Our spiritual pilgrimage begins as we depart USA for Jerusalem!

---

### **Day 2: Monday, October 19 – Paris/Tel Aviv**

Arrive Tel Aviv airport where we will be welcomed by our tour guide and be taken to the Church of St. Peter for Mass before heading to a hotel in Netanya. (Mass in St. Peter depends on flight arrival time.)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**Attention:** *Schedule on this day especially subject to change depending on flight details/arrival time.*

### **Day 3: Tuesday, October 20 – Haifa/Mount Carmel/Nazareth/Cana**

After breakfast, we drive to Haifa and to Stella Maris Convent of the Carmelites where we will visit the Cave of the Prophet Elijah (Mass at the Carmelite convent) and spend silent prayer (entrance fees included). Next stop, Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, the Church of St. Gabriel and Mary's Well. Return to bus to travel to Cana where the first miracle of Jesus took place through His mother Mary's request and where couples have the opportunity to renew their vows. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

---

### **Day 4: Wednesday, October 21 – Tagbha/St. Peter's Primacy/Beatitudes/Galilee Region**

After early morning breakfast, we go to Tagbha, the site of the multiplication of fish and bread and to a very special site of St. Peter's Primacy where Jesus asked Peter if he "loves him" three-times and asks Peter to feed His lambs and sheep. Next we visit Mount Beatitudes and enjoy a taste of freshly caught tilapia known as "St. Peter's fish" for lunch (this lunch included). We then proceed to Capernaum (entrance included) by St. Peter's House for Mass. Enjoy the unforgettable boat ride (boat included) to the Sea of God. Dinner at our hotel.

---

### **Day 5, Thursday, October 22 – Mt. Tabor/Jericho/Jaffa/Jordan River/Jerusalem**

After breakfast, we drive up to Mount Tabor (Taxi included) to visit the actual site where Jesus was transfigured before his apostles St. Peter, St. James and St. John at the Franciscan Church of the Transfiguration. Next, we drive to the Mt. of Temptation in Jericho and then visit the Jordan River where the Pope visited and claimed to be the actual site where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist. If allowed, we will ask to be blessed with water at this site. Proceed to the hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

---

### **Day 6, Friday, October 23 – Ein Karem/Bethlehem the Nativity/Shepherd's Field**

After Breakfast we head to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and to the Church of the Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the 'Magnificat'. Continue to Shepherd's Field where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. Then visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem that stands upon the site where Jesus was born. Mass in Bethlehem or the Shepherds Fields by the Cave. We will also visit the Carmelite Monastery to pray at the relics of Sister of Jesus "St. Mary Baouardy" who was canonized by Pope Francis on May 2015. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

## **Day 7, Saturday, October 24 – Jerusalem/Mt. Olives/Dominus Flevit/Gethsemane/Cave of Betrayal/Cave of Assumptio/Pater Notre**

---

After breakfast head to Mt. of Olives where the group will visit the Pater Nostre (entrance included) church with the Lord's Prayer in many languages, and the Ascension (entrance included) from where ascended to Heaven. Afterwards, groups get to see a dramatic view of the Old City from the Mount of Olives, revealing a city with 4000 years of history. From this point, see much of what makes Jerusalem such a unique city to the three major religions – Judaism, Christianity and Islam. Next we walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Then to Gethsemane, the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed His last prayer before his arrest and the Gethsemane Grotto. We will also visit the cave of betrayal and the cave of the Assumption of Mary to heaven. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

## **Day 8, Sunday, October 25 – Stations of the Cross/Church of the Holy Sepulchre/St. Anne's Church/Ecce Homo Church of the Holy Sepulcher/Western Wall/Upper Room**

---

Early in the morning we will walk carrying a Cross on the Way of the Cross until we reach the Church the Holy Sepulcher where we celebrate Mass. Free time will be given here for prayer and devotion. Back to the hotel for a late breakfast and a little rest. Return to the Old City of Jerusalem to visit St. Anne's Church (entrance included), the home of Mary's parents St. Ann and St. Joachim where the Blessed Virgin Mary was born. Pass the Ecce Homo (entrance included) where Pilate proclaimed "Behold the Man"! Next stop the Wailing Wall, the holiest place for those of the Jewish faith. Spend time in silence and reflection at the Cenacle, the Upper Room of the Last Supper and where the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles. Next, we go to Dormition Abbey to reflect on the life lived by our Blessed Mother. Here we will spend time to give honor and praise to God for Mary's YES and for the example she left us in living her life of total submission to the Holy Spirit to do God's Will. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

## **Day 9, Monday, October 26 – Emmaus/Dead Sea/Bethany (time permitting)**

---

Today, we drive to Emmaus for Mass where Jesus appeared to the two apostles after His Resurrection. In the afternoon, we stop at the Dead Sea to feel or swim the salty, warm water. Time permitting visit the Church built on the traditional site of the house of Mary and Martha and their brother Lazarus (entrance to Lazarus tomb is included). Dinner is at a local restaurant today, return to the hotel in Jerusalem for overnight.

On to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, the Church of St. Gabriel and Mary's Well then to CANA where the first miracle of Jesus took place through His mother's intercession and where couples renew their vow. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 4 – October 21 Wednesday TAGBHA/ST.PETER'S PRIMACY/ BEATITUDES /GALILEE REGION After breakfast, we make an early morning visit in Tagbha, the site of the multiplication of fish and bread and to a very special site St. Peter's Primacy where Jesus asked Peter if He loves him three-time and to feed His lambs and sheep. We visit Mount Beatitudes. Enjoy a taste of freshly caught tilapia known as "St. Peter's fish for lunch (Lunch included). then proceed to Capernaum (Entrance included) by St. Peter's House for Mass. Enjoy the unforgettable boat ride (Boat included) to the Sea of God. Dinner at our hotel. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 – October 22 Thursday MT TABOR/JERICHO/JAFFA/JORDAN RIVER/ JERUSALEM After breakfast, we drive up to Mount Tabor (Taxi included) to visit the actual site where Jesus was transfigured before apostles St. Peter, St. James and St. John at the Franciscan Church of Transfiguration. We drive to the Mt. of Temptation in Jericho and then visit the Jordan River where the Pope visited and claimed to be the actual site where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist and if allowed, to experience being blessed with water at the actual site. Proceed to the hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B, D)



Afterwards, groups get to see a dramatic view of the Old City from the Mount of Olives, revealing a city with 4000 years of history. From this point, see much of what makes Jerusalem such a unique city to the three major religions – Judaism, Christianity and Islam. walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem.
